



Are you interested in being a Trail Auditor?

Snoman will be holding a Trail Auditors Training Session this fall with the hopes of adding four (4) more trail auditors to the provincial trail audit team. We are looking to add one auditor in each of the following regions Eastern, Central, Interlake, and Western

If you are interested, you can apply by filling out this form. A maximum of 2 people per region will be selected by Snoman. Prior to the upcoming season, those selected will be required to attend a training session and will also receive one-on-one training on the trails with a Regional senior auditor.

Pre-requisites for entry:

- up-to-date online trail signing course;
- minimum three years of signing experience; and
- flexible schedule.

Compensation: Trail auditors are paid for the use of their personal snowmobile at a rate of \$175 per day and up to a max \$0.75 per km for the use of their vehicle for travel to audit and back. There is a maximum of 8 hours for an audit at a rate of \$20/hour. If needed, hotel and meals are also reimbursed as per receipts submitted to the office.
